SET UP & OTHER INFORMATION

- ◆ Thursday, September 6th after 12 noon or Friday, September 7th after 2:30pm
- ◆ No set up allowed during Students Day on Friday, September 7th from 8am – 2pm
 - ◆ Check in at the Visitor center upon arrival.
- ◆ Vehicles must be moved from the “Village” area to the backfield parking area behind the red barn ½ hour before the event opens at 9:00am.
 - ◆ Participants are to remain for the entire event
 - ◆ No tearing down until closing on Sunday at 5pm.
 - ◆ No alcoholic beverages or pets on site.
- ◆ No plastic or pop-up tents unless they are disguised as period dwellings.
- ◆ Lyme Village will provide firewood, showers & a Saturday evening dinner.
- ◆ Overnight camping fee \$5 per person before July 1st/after July 1st \$10 per person.
